The cave is an exit from the thermodynamics of everyday life. We enter a difference in light, atmosphere, and comprehensibility. The cave is the underworld, the chthonic temple, the entrails and womb of the earth. Life seeps out, but not life as we know it above-ground.

Ancestral Ca²⁺ is a live performance, installation, and sound piece that explores cave-feelings, cave-speech, and cave-thought via calcium in its elemental and ionic form.

From the pre-Cambrian to a futural autumn festival dedicated to the Gorgon sisters, this performance explores different scales and planes of bio-mineralised existence.

Participants are invited into the cave with [me, Deborah] as we enter different physical planes, chemical species, time scales and post/non/in-human perspectives.
